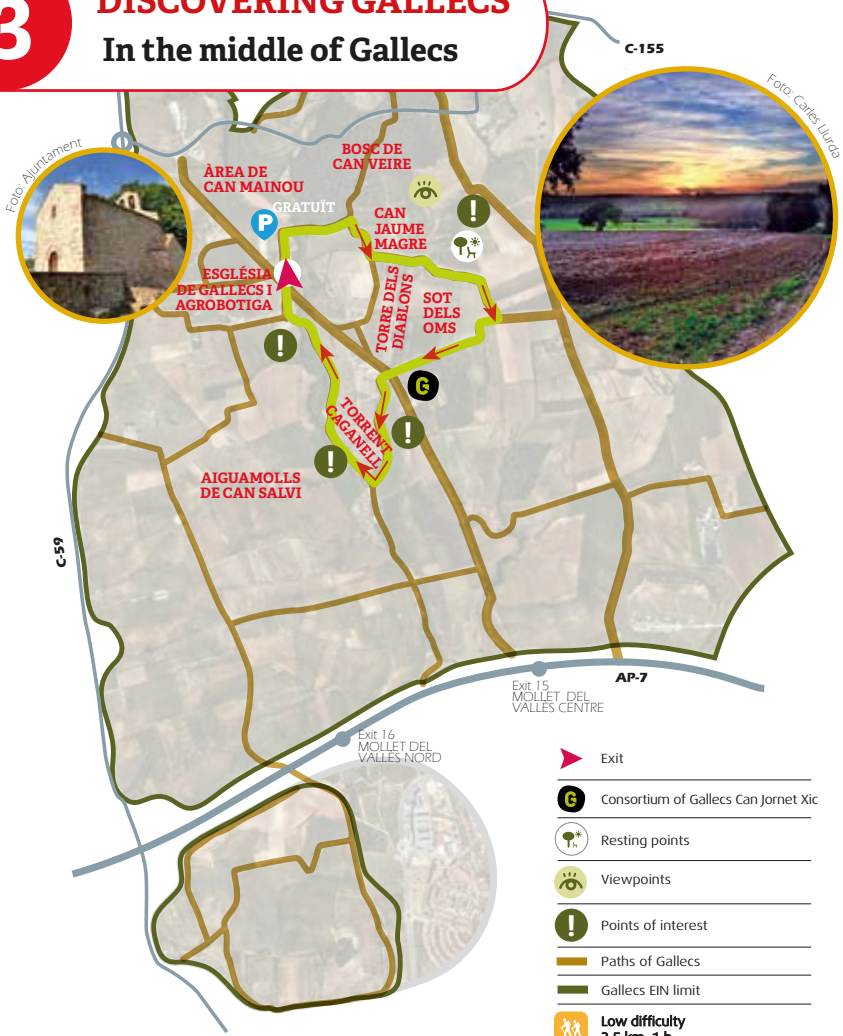

DISCOVERING GALLECS

In the middle of Gallecs



We start the route along the path behind the church of Santa Maria de Gallecs, passing the leisure area of Can Mainou, crossing the Caganell stream towards the forest of Can Veire, Can Jaume Magre and the Diablons stream. From there to the Bache dels Oms Pond, the Can Salvi wetlands and back to the point of origin. In the stream, the riverside woods provide freshness in summer with plane trees, poplars, small-leaved ash trees and elms. In the wetlands of Can Salvi, you can see collvered ducks, green woodpeckers, kingfishers and even the occasional leper pond turtle.
